

History – Children will be finding out what life was like for those in the First World War, including soldiers on the frontline, those left behind at home and even female spies.

Maths – We will be focusing on the four major operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. This is the foundation to many parts of the Year 5/6 curriculum, so the children will be applying this understanding to other areas, including fractions.

English – *Stay Where You Are and Then Leave* by John Boyne

Through our class text, we will be writing recipes from the First World War, diary entries from soldiers in the trenches and poetry inspired by World War One.

PSHE – This half term we will discuss rights and responsibilities alongside our school core values.

Art – To support our learning of the First World War, children will be producing silhouette art in memory of fallen soldiers.
