This will help support their comprehension skills as well as secure their knowledge of any new words they are reading.

Homework this half term will consist of reading and spellings. Spellings will be set on a Friday and be tested the following Friday. As the term progresses we will add more homework as appropriate.

PE this year will take place on a Tuesday and Wednesday. Please can you ensure PE kits are in school and earrings are removed for these sessions.

We will hold an open class after school on Wednesday 18th October, this is an opportunity for your child to share their work with you. The class will be open from 3:15-4:15.
